# OSPI School Meal Programs Reference Sheet

## **Local School Wellness Policy**

Local Education Agencies (LEAs) play a critical role in promoting wellness among students, staff, and families. To ensure schools create a healthy environment for student health and learning, LEAs operating the National School Lunch Program or other federal Child Nutrition Programs are required to establish a local school wellness policy for all schools under its jurisdiction.

### Requirements

- Develop a current Wellness Policy. This policy must:
  - o Include specific goals for nutrition education, physical activity, nutrition promotion, and other school-based activities to promote student wellness.
  - State nutrition guidelines for all foods available on the school campus. These guidelines
    must be consistent with federal regulations for school meal nutrition and Smart Snacks in
    School standards.
  - Only allow for food and beverage marketing that meet the Smart Snacks in School nutrition standards.
- Designate one or more school official(s) with authority to ensure Wellness Policy compliance at each school under its jurisdiction.
- Make the Local Wellness Policy available to the public forward facing.
- Review and update the School Wellness Policy regularly.
- Invite stakeholders to participate in the development, review, updates, and implementation of the Local Wellness Policy; encourage public comment and input.
- Conduct a triannual assessment, to determine compliance and progress, which compares the Local Wellness Policy to the model local wellness policies. This assessment must include all schools under the LEA.
- Develop an assessment report that describes school's compliance and alignment with the Wellness Policy and the model wellness policy. This report must be made available to the public.



#### **Details:**

- Wellness Policies are tailored to the unique needs of each LEA and their schools.
- Templates can be used if personalized and includes at a minimum the above noted requirements. OSPI does not provide template policies.
- Documentation required for Administrative Review:
  - Compliance with community involvement requirements (copy of the newsletter announcing/inviting stakeholders).
  - Wellness Policy and annual updates.
  - Triannual assessment for each school under its jurisdiction and comparison to model policies.
  - Link or web address to where these are publicly available (cannot be hidden in School Board Policy unless directly linked from main webpages).
