### **CAPITAL GRANT PROGRAMS AVAILABLE FOR FACILITY-RELATED IMPROVEMENTS**

The legislature has appropriated funding in the 2019-2021 Capital Budget for facility-related grants to school districts. Each appropriation has a specific use and amount of funding, as well as unique minimum criteria to be used for grant award purposes.

- Career Preparation and Launch Equipment Grants - \$1.0 million
  - Career and Technical Education Equipment Grants - \$1.0 Million
- Healthy Kids Healthy Schools - \$3.0 million
  - Water Bottle Filling Stations and Replacement of Lead-Contaminated Drinking Water Fixtures Grants
  - Children's Physical Health Grants
  - Children's Nutrition Grants
- Small District Modernization - \$20.0 million
  - Project Planning Grants - \$1.0 million
  - Building Systems Modernization Grants - \$19.0 million
- School District Health & Safety - \$5.0 million
  - Emergency Repair Pool Grants - \$2.0 million (Administered outside of iGrants)
  - Urgent Repair Grants - \$3.0 million
  - Equal Access Grants - \$1.0 million

- Distressed School Grants - \$5.0 million
  - Modular Classroom Grants (Portable Replacement) - \$5.0 Million

OSPI anticipates these grant opportunities to become available later this summer. Grant applications will be administered using OSPI's iGrants system and school districts will be notified when grant applications will be accepted.
