

"After-Exit" Running Start Declaration of Intent Form 2023 Summer

Pursuant to [Substitute Senate Bill 5187\(522\)\(2\)\(i\)](#), Class of 2023 students who have graduated by June; are within 15 credits of an associate of arts, science, or technical arts (AA/AS/ATA) degree; AND have met the 1.20 average annual full time equivalent (AAFTE) limitation for 2022–23 by June may enroll in summer quarter Running Start. Enrollment is limited to community and technical colleges and only the courses required to complete an associate degree, up to a maximum of 15 college credits. Complete this form to verify each student’s eligibility and ensure the graduation-eligible students’ enrollment remains open until the end of the summer quarter.
