**Purpose:** OSPI is amending WAC 392-191A-030 to update the definitions of “Certificated classroom teacher” and “teacher” to reflect changes in certification categories enacted by the Professional Educators Standards Board (PESB) in WAC 181-79A-140. The revision ensures the rules reflect state statutes. OSPI is also amending WAC 392-191A-080 to update the frequency of the comprehensive evaluation for a teacher or principal eligible for a focused evaluation, from at least once every four years to at least once every six years. This change aligns with E2SHB 1139 (2019).
